



CORNERSTONE COMMUNITY CHURCH COVID 19 MANAGEMENT PLAN

18 March 2020

With the President declaring a National State of Disaster due to the Coronavirus (Covid 19), as a church we need to safeguard our congregants and associated persons. In addition, as responsible citizens, we need to take responsibility and follow protocols with regards to combating the virus.

As such, the church leadership has implemented the following measures immediately:

- Congregants / visitors are to take ownership of their own hygiene after the church ensures that congregants are made aware of the symptoms, controls and social distancing required managing the virus spread. This includes this document.
- Two services will be hosted. The first service will commence at 9am while the second service will begin at 10am. The 10am service will be Livestreamed for those who are unable to attend the service for health reasons.
- Entrance into each service will be limited to a maximum of 90 people.
- Please exercise extra caution when utilizing the Baby Room. No children under the age of 4 will be allowed to enter the baby room. Please use disinfectant when entering the baby room. Please make use of Livestream service at home should your baby be ill.
- Any church member or visitors who show symptoms are not to attend church and to contact local health authorities immediately should the symptoms persist. Congregants / visitors to self quarantine for 14 days or follow a medical practitioner advice. Instead, congregants are to make use of the Livestream service during the 10am service.
- If any immediate family members of congregants / visitors are sick they are to self isolate until illness is identified. The congregant / visitor is to also self isolate for a minimum of 14 days or as directed by a medical practitioner, should the family member show positive symptoms.
- If an congregant / visitor or immediate family member shows any symptoms, they are to contact medical services immediately, the Health Department 24 hour hotline number is 0800 029 999, or Whatsapp Hi to 0600 123456
- Sunday briefings are to be held to raise awareness and to ensure the latest information is given to congregants / visitors.
- Hand washing and Informative posters have been placed in all bathrooms and notice boards;
- Paper towels have been placed in all bathrooms with soaps and hand wash;
- Spray bottles with Dettol and water are to be placed at entrance to the church;
- Following protocols as a minimum to be highly encouraged by all congregants and visitors to Cornerstone Community Church:
 - EMPHASISE THE IMPORTANCE OF THE 20 SECOND HANDWASH AND REGULAR WASHING;

- KEEP A MIN OF 1M DISTANCE BETWEEN CONGREGANTS;
- NO SHAKING OF HANDS OR TOUCHING IS ADVISED, USE ELBOW GREETING IF NEED BE;
- COUGH OR SNEEZE INTO A TISSUE, WHICH IS DISPOSED OF SAFELY, OR THE BENT ELBOW;
- Keep the church well ventilated and try not to keep closed up during winter period;
- Disposable gloves are to be available for all cleaning personnel, who are to concentrate on keeping all church areas and bathrooms clean at increased frequencies.
- All bins with paper towel to be incinerated or disposed of safely;
